Friday, October 15, 2021 - USA to Dublin

Depart your hometown and take an overnight flight across the Atlantic. Enjoy inflight entertainment and meal service as you travel to start your vacation.

Saturday, October 16, 2021 – DUBLIN ARRIVAL & GALWAY

After customs and immigration formalities at Dublin Airport, your CIE Tours driver/ guide will welcome you to Ireland. Have breakfast at the Coachman's Inn before traveling across Ireland from east to west today. Drive through the fertile midland region, which has many farms and marketing towns. All along the way you can see how Irish people make a living from agriculture, one of the most important sources of revenue for Ireland. Travel through the towns of Moate and Ballinasloe to Galway. Upon arrival join a local guide for a gentle walking tour. See the medieval city walls, Lynch's Castle and the narrow streets. Transfer to your nearby hotel, check in and settle into you room. In the evening, join your fellow travelers for a welcome drink followed by dinner in the hotel restaurant.

Sunday, October 17, 2021 - KYLEMORE ABBEY

Stop at Kylemore Abbey for a tour of the elegant mansion and church, set beside a tranquil lake. Learn of the tales of tragedy, romance and royal visits. Also, walk through the magical Victorian walled garden. Next, travel through Connemara Region to admire the sweeping views of boglands and misty mountains. As you drive along you will see many sheep that graze freely and tracts of bogland where some people hand-cut peat for home heating. Return to Galway, where you are free for individual pursuits and dining.

Monday, October 18, 2021 - CLIFFS OF MOHER & KILLARNEY

Leaving Galway, drive along the coast of County Clare to visit the Cliffs of Moher, which overlook the shimmering Atlantic Ocean. Harry Potter and the Half Blood Prince along with the Princess Bride have scenes that were filmed at this stunning landmark. Then make your way to the charming town of Killarney, where you will check into your hotel for dinner and overnight stay.

Tuesday, October 19, 2021 - JAUNTING CAR & RING OF KERRY

Today, take a horse-drawn jaunting car ride through the grounds of the Killarney National Park. Next, set off to explore the Ring of Kerry, which consist of over 100 miles of marvelous scenery. See some of Ireland's highest peaks on one side of the road and a coastline scattered with golden beaches and rocky headlands on the other. There will also be plenty of stops to take-in the scenery and to snap photos. Head back to Killarney for a free evening.

Wednesday, October 20, 2021 - BLARNEY CASTLE & KINSALE

Depart Killarney and journey through the rugged countryside to Blarney. While

here, you can climb the battlements of Blarney Castle and kiss the famous "Stone of Eloquence." Next, take a brief walking tour with a local guide to learn the history of Kinsale. The town has been a favorite for artists due to its steep, narrow streets, quirky shopfronts and many fine Georgian houses. Check into your hotel and settle in before dinner with your group.

Thursday, October 21, 2021 - 9/11 MEMORIAL & CHARLES FORT

After breakfast, visit the Garden of Remembrance to honor the many firemen who lost their lives during 9/11. Next, visit Charles Fort, which was constructed in the late 17th century on the site of an earlier coastal fortification. As one of the largest military forts in the country, Charles Fort has been associated with some of the most momentous events in Irish history. The balance of the day is free in Kinsale, which is dubbed the "Gourmet Capital" of Ireland.

Friday, October 22, 2021 - DUBLIN HIGHLIGHTS

Journey to the lively city of Dublin and set off on a guided tour. The city has been molded through the centuries by economic, political and artistic influences that has shaped its architecture. Stop at Trinity College to see the Book of Kells, an 8th century illuminated manuscript of the gospels and see the Old Library. After checking into your hotel, the balance of the afternoon and evening is at leisure.

Saturday, October 23, 2021 - HOP ON HOP OFF DUBLIN

Today, enjoy the day at leisure in Dublin, where you can choose from a wide variety of pursuits. Use your Hop on Hop off pass to visit several places. Also, using your vouchers you may either visit the Guinness Storehouse or Old Jameson Distillery for a tour and sample of the finished product. Moreover, there are many museums, shop and pubs you can visit.

This evening, head to Taylors Three Rock for quality Irish food that is accompanied with lively music and dance.

Sunday, October 24, 2021 - RETURN TO THE UNITED STATES

Transfer to Dublin Airport and check in for your flight. You may do some last minute shopping at the duty free stores before boarding your aircraft and flying back to the United States.
